Making arrangements with a volunteer...

- Find a nearby volunteer from the list. Phone them, explain what you need and give them your **name**, **address** and **phone number**.
- If you need shopping, agree in advance how and when you will pay the volunteer cash or cheque? In advance or on delivery?
- Volunteers will let you know when they expect to arrive. They will leave items on the doorstep and will not enter your home.
- At all times, please keep a distance of at least 2 metres from the volunteer at the door, and don't open the door if you are not sure who is calling.
- Tell the volunteer if you want somebody to keep in touch by phone.
- If something doesn't feel right, don't open the door.
- If you are worried about your safety, inform the volunteer.
